- March 15, 2021: Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and Special Education Self-contained classroom (Tentative)
- March 22, 2021: All Students 1st- 8th Grades (Tentative)

Face-to-Face Guidelines

In order to adhere to the CDC guidelines and practice social distancing to ensure the safety of staff and students, the following procedures will be implemented:

Remote Learning Guidelines

Students will:

- Be on time for class
- Not leave class early
- Understand that attendance is mandatory
- Review all assigned work.
- Complete all of your assigned work by the due date
- Ask clarifying questions through Remind, Canvas, email, or class chat on Big-Blue-Button when you need help or do not understand
- Be respectful to yourself, teachers, and peer
- Maintain your e-learning equipment in good condition.
- Notify the Technology Department of any technical issues or damage to school-owned devices immediately. This means no later than the next school day.
- Charge the laptop or iPad fully each night
- Communicate with teachers through your school-issued email account or Canvas. Your email account should remain YOUR NAME.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Anyone who is on school property is required to wear an appropriate face covering. Visitors will not be permitted to enter the school buildings unless approved by the building Principal.
