Recommended Changes:

- In May 2014, the curriculum adoption committee sent a needs assessment survey to teachers asking to prioritize the curricular areas in most need of adoption first and soliciting input on the format (i.e. traditional textbook or digital platform).
- The curriculum adoption committee voted to adopt the Read Well curriculum for Kindergarten and 1st Grade to be implemented in 2014-2015. This curriculum is currently utilized in the LAP program as an intervention tool.
- The PE/Health and Fitness supplies will be purchased as well in 2014. Many new supplies have been recently replaced with Griffin Foundation dollars.
