



GRIFFIN SCHOOL DISTRICT #324 BUS SCHEDULE INFORMATION

The AM and PM school bus routes have been posted to the [Griffin Transportation](#) website. Some of the bus routes have been modified this year. **Please note - the route schedules are preliminary and subject to time changes throughout the year.**

- Please review the [Bus Rules & Safety Procedures](#) with your children prior to and throughout the school year.
- Your children will be given a bus assignment based on your home address, allowing us to balance the number of students on each bus and the length of ride (as much as efficiently possible). Capital High School students must register for bus service on the Olympia School District Transportation website using the [online registration form](#).
- Students should always be at the bus stop five minutes prior to the expected bus arrival time and should not be alarmed if the bus is later than anticipated. The Capital High School buses will be traveling the roads at the same time as the Griffin K-8 buses. Therefore, other buses may pass your children before one stops to pick them up. The Griffin K-8 buses will have "K8" on the front corner by the bus # to help distinguish the difference.
- The first week of school students may arrive home later than anticipated. We make every effort to ensure students are on the correct bus prior to leaving the school grounds, subsequently causing bus departure to be later than normal. If you become concerned, please feel free to call Griffin Transportation, 866-4544. Our staff will contact the bus driver for their location.
- Kindergarten students must be met at the bus stop by an adult or older sibling.

PICKING UP AFTER SCHOOL?

For student safety and accountability, please report to the school office when it is necessary to pick your student up after school. If your student is already on the bus, office staff will contact the school bus driver and your student will be directed to the office to meet you.

DISPLAY YOUR ADDRESS!

School bus drivers must be able to read your address from both directions of the street and the numbers should be recognizable from up to 100 feet. The Griffin Fire Department offers address markers that work perfectly, not to mention it allows you to be located if an emergency occurs at your home! To order new address markers call 866-9000.
