Fall Coaches Reports:

- Cross Country: Jason Castle
 - 3 kids qualified for states- Even Schapman, Haileigh Bissett, Carlie Schlaud
 - 1978 was the last time we had 3 qualify for states
 - 34 degrees at Regionals, 74 degrees at states. Not ideal temps for distance running
 - Coach Castle thanked the boosters for \$ for food for the athletes and coaches for states
- Volleyball: Jim Fish
 - Regionals was good. Lost in regional finals in 5 to Notre Dame Prep with 4 freshman starting.
- Football: Bubba Goines
 - 9-0 at 3 week pause
