Treasurer's Report: Kristine Bickel

- Current Balance: \$17,830.78
 - \$10,000 was approved to spend on Scoreboard previously
 - \$300 going to Bowling for Food for Regionals in Gaylord for 2 days
 - \$1,300 being moved to CHOF account for work on the HOF Wall. This was approved to come out of the Booster Account previously and was taken from the CHOF account instead.
- CHOF (Community Hall of Fame) Account
 - Current Balance: \$1,650.53
 - Adding the \$1300 back in will put us at \$2,950.53

Athletic Department Update: Al Margrif

- We will be hosting the Boys Basketball Regional here March 16th & 18th
