

In collaboration with our state and local health officials, Trinity School will follow guidelines to the extent possible, outlined by the CDC, WHO and OSHA when considering ways in which Trinity School can help protect our students, teachers, administrators, and staff, and to slow the spread of COVID-19, as well as how to implement these considerations. Implementation will be guided by what is feasible, practical, acceptable, and tailored to the needs of our school and community.

COVID-19 is believed to spread by respiratory droplets released when people talk, cough, or sneeze. It is thought that the virus may spread to hands from a contaminated surface and then to the nose or mouth, causing infection. Personal prevention practices (such as mask, handwashing, physical distancing, staying home when sick, and the COVID questionnaire) and environmental cleaning and disinfection are important principles that Trinity School will implement to help lower the risk of COVID-19 exposure and spread during school and activities.
