

COOPERATIVE SPORTS

- Tech uses a certified Athletic trainer supplied by Wellspan
- We have direct access to specialists through the Wellspan network that will not require an appointment
- All athletes are covered by our insurance during the season
- Students will need to find their own ride to Tech for practices
- When arriving at Tech, athletes are to park in the student parking lot and enter the building at door #32 by the locker room hallway. (If the door is locked, enter through the Adult ED entrance on the Queen Street side of the building)
- Tech will transport athletes to and from athletic contests
- An activity bus to transport students home after practices is available. Students are dropped off at a school near their home.
- Tech will supply team equipment and uniforms
- Students are eligible for all Tech athletic awards and the All Sports Banquet as well as awards and records at their own school.

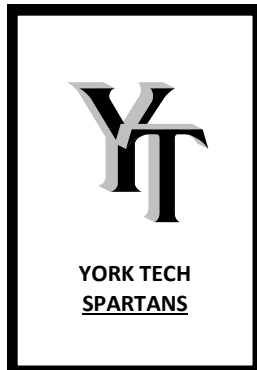

Spartan Sports in the 21st Century

York County School of Technology is a Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) and York Adams Interscholastic Athletic Association (YAIAA) member school. Students participating in sports programs at Tech are governed by these bodies and are entitled to compete for league, district, and state titles. Tech has been YAIAA Champions in Football, Cross Country, Softball, and Track. Nate Weaver was Tech's most recent wrestler to become

the Class AAA District III Champion at 275 lb. and finished third in the state. Rene Arey became the first Tech female to become YAIAA and District III Champion in track in the javelin. In 2013, Dani Aikins and Cheyenne Fulcher were named PIAA AAA All State Honorable Mention softball. Kirstyn Evans was the YAIAA and District III Champion in the high jump and finished 7th in the state in 2016. Boys Track finished first in the league in 2016.

Philosophy of Tech Co-op Sports

The York County School of Technology believes participation in high school athletics offers opportunities to learn, promote, and reinforce the qualities that influence students to become productive citizens. The sports co-op program offers students the opportunity to participate in high school sports that are not offered at his/her school. By doing co-ops, students are able to stay in an academic setting that best fits their needs without having to give up a particular sport.

Cooperative Sports Programs

Tech offers 16 varsity co-op sports.

- **FALL:** **FIELD HOCKEY, FOOTBALL, CHEERLEADING, CROSS COUNTRY,** Girls **VOLLEYBALL,** and **GOLF** open YCD. Additionally, **FH** is open to **York Catholic** and **Christian School of York.** **GOLF** and **FOOTBALL** are also open to **CSY.**
- **WINTER:** **WRESTLING** is open to Christian School of York, William Penn, York Catholic, and York Country Day. **CHEERLEADING** is open to YCD and CSY students, Boys and Girls **WINTER TRACK** are open to York Catholic and YCD.
- **SPRING:** Boys and Girls **TRACK & FIELD** open to York Catholic and YCD students, while **SOFTBALL** accepts CSY and YCD students and **BASEBALL** is only open to YCD.

Co-op Eligibility Details

Athletes will need to supply York Tech with the following:

- PIAA CIPPE physical form dated June 1, 2020 or later. (copy)
- Completed Winter recertification form
- Signed CO-OP Transportation Permission form and COVID-19 Waiver
- Sign for York Tech Student/Parent Athletic Handbook on-line
- Sign for Team Rules
- Completed Emergency card

Academic eligibility will be determined by the student's school. In some cases academic eligibility requirements may vary from one school to another. In all cases, athletes must meet the PIAA academic minimum requirements to participate.
